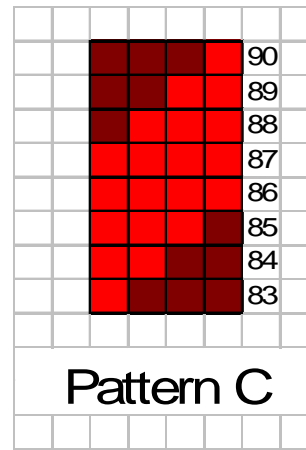


Work rounds 83-90 of **Pattern C** starting at the bottom of the chart. You will repeat the pattern 40 times in each round.

Rounds 91-92: Knit in Colour A
Rounds 93-94: knit in Colour B
Rounds 95-96: knit in Colour A
Rounds 97-98: Knit in Colour B
Rounds 99-100: Knit in Colour A
Rounds 101-102: Knit in Colour B
Rounds 103-104: Knit in Colour A
Rounds 105-106: Knit in Colour B
Rounds 106- 107: Knit in Colour A
Cast off all stitches.

Lay flat and sew up the cast on edge of the bag.



The bag uses a strap that is knit flat (not in the round) in Moss Stitch and is felted separately then stitched into the inside of the bag along the bottom and up the sides.

Strap:

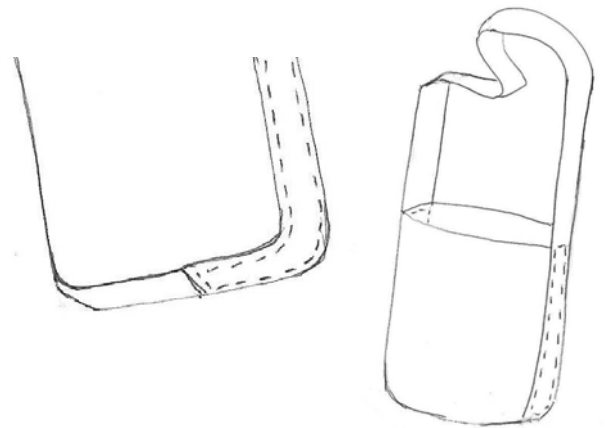
Using 2 strands of Colour A cast on 11 stitches.

Row 1: Knit 1, * Purl 1, Knit 1 repeat from * to end of row.

Repeat Row 1 until strap is at least 165cm long.

Making up:

Turn bag inside out. The two ends of the strap will meet at the base of the bag. Using Colour A begin stitching from the base up one side. Join other end at the base and work up the other side. Turn back out to right side for felting.



Felting:

Felt in the washing machine with a little detergent. **** **EVERY WASHING MACHINE WORKS DIFFERENTLY****** Start out with a 30 degree quick wash. When you take the bag out of the machine pull it into the desired shape. If the bag is not felted enough, wash again on 30 degrees. If it is still not felted enough, try a 40 degree wash. If it still is not felted enough try putting in an old towel, or a pair of jeans. Remember you can always felt it more, you will have spent a lot of time knitting the bag, so take your time felting it so you do not end up with a postage stamp sized bag!

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
